A Resolution in Support of Math Pathways Changes

WHEREAS, the North Dakota Student Association (NDSA) represents the voice of North Dakota's 45,000 public college and university students; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of NDSA is to represent all students enrolled in the North Dakota University System (NDUS) and advocate on issues of higher education in support of access, affordability, quality, and the student experience; and,

WHEREAS, in September 2021, the NDSA supported the NDUS instituting Math Pathways that will allow students to take mathematical courses most suitable for their major, and,

WHEREAS, on May 23rd and 24th, 2022, during a NDUS workgroup, changes were made to Math Pathways for students to complete the Mathematics General Education Requirement, and,

WHEREAS, during the workgroup, MATH 104 Finite Mathematics was revised, and MATH 110 Mathematics in Society was added as an additional Math Pathway, increasing the total number of ways to complete a Mathematics General Education Requirement to four, and,

WHEREAS, the NDUS common course numbering and GERTA approval proposed changes and additions are expected to commence in the Fall of 2023; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the NDSA continues to support and acknowledges the effort put by the NDUS to create additional pathways for completing General Education requirements; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the NDSA will continue to support Math Pathways that will allow students to branch out into their fields and apply mathematical concepts to real world situations.
